Recreational Fire Burn Permit

The Property Owner listed on this Permit **must** be present at the site of the fire.

- This Permit is not transferable. This permit may be revoked for any violation of the TTPOA Rules of Conduct, State and Local Burning Violations.
- This Permit is not for the use of backyard debris burning, a separate permit must be applied for to burn backyard debris.
- Before you start the fire you must check wind direction and do not proceed to burn if wind speeds are over 10mph.
- Only Burn aged Dry Wood or charcoal.
- The location of the fire should not be within 15 feet of any structure.
- Remember if the remnants of the fire are too hot to touch, its too hot to leave.
- The total burn area of a recreational fire should be no more then three(3) feet surface area and no more then two(2) feet high.
